Re-opening of the school

The re-opening of the school to YR went well this week. The children came into school happily and were delighted to chat to their friends and the teaching staff. The children spent time learning new routines such as; handwashing, social distancing and 'catch it-bin it-kill it' They also enjoyed learning together, mirroring the remote learning of their classmates offsite. Although we are delighted to have the children back we very much miss those who are working from home. The key worker bubble has been steadily increasing and next week we plan to have some of the nursery children in with Reception children on a Thursday and Friday Morning – from 9.15 am- 12.15 am . This group will be with Mrs Hawley and Mrs Hilditch. We will then be near full capacity regarding the bubbles we have each day. Please give us 48 hours notice if you want to enter a bubble.

Cleaning the school

As you will know, our cleaning staff undertake a deep clean of the school on a Wednesday afternoon each week. During the week, Mrs Hearndon comes in for an hour each day at lunchtime to perform hygiene control across the school. Staff that deal with sickness wear PPE when looking after sick children.

CORONAVIRUS SYMPTOMS

If an adult or child has symptoms of Covid 19 they should immediately go home and self- isolate for 7 days. If Covid 19 is confirmed the rest of their bubble must go home and isolate for 14 days. If we have no staff to lead that bubble then the children would have to go home if there was no leader.
