Dear Parents and Carers

As you may already know, in the academic year 2020/21, Relationships Education and Health Education will become statutory in all primary schools in England.

As a Catholic school, our mission is to support the spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of all of our pupils, rooted in the wisdom and teaching of the Church. The *Life to the Full* programme has been approved by our diocese. Furthermore, the scheme providers Ten Ten have entered into a partnership with the Catholic Education Service and the Department for Education, therefore we are confident that this programme is a very good fit for our school.

We are inviting feedback on our approach, and particularly on the key decisions that we need to take regarding the teaching of certain topics. To this end, we have opened a consultation period during which we would welcome the feedback of parents.

Ten Ten have provided an online Parent Consultation. This is a simple-to-follow, short online course which:

- Outlines the statutory changes that will take place.
- Articulates a vision for Catholic Relationships and Health Education.
- Explains how Life to the Full aims to help us fulfil the statutory curriculum with a Catholic ethos.
- Provides some information about key decisions we need to make, in consultation with parents and governors.
- Answers some Frequently Asked Questions.
