## What is Family Learning?

Family Learning is learning that takes place among family members including parents, grandparents, and carers. It's about discovering and exploring things together; learning in a relaxed atmosphere and is an opportunity for parents and carers to discover how their children learn and develop.

Some Family Learning courses are for adults and children together, while others are just for adults. All of our courses are **free**, with resources provided.

We run courses across Warwickshire, in a variety of settings, including Schools, Nurseries, Children and Family Centres and Community Venues. Some of our courses are 'open to the community' and some are 'invitation only' for parents with children attending specific settings.

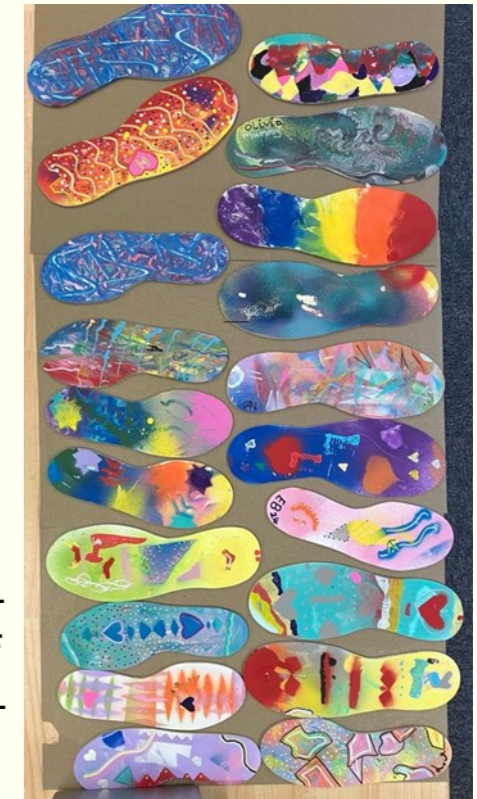
